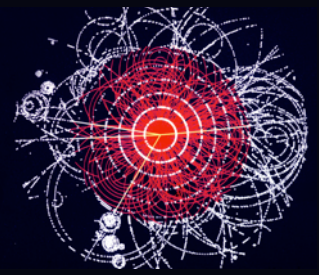

## 2013 KINETIC JAZZ FESTIVAL

22nd to 27th of January  
St Luke's Church 11 Stanmore Rd, Enmore

This year's Kinetic Jazz Festival is characterised by a stream of new projects especially created for the occasion. And by unusual band sizes: a series of intimate duos alternate with quite large combos. This sense of playing with scope continues with performances by our 18-strong Kinetic Jazz Orchestra, and by the inclusion of some newly formed young bands with a fresh perspective on groove.

Artists and projects include:

- International flute master Kaoru Watanabe (courtesy of TaikOz- <http://www.watanabekaoru.com>) in concert with local world music master Kim Sanders exploring flutes from around the world.
- Pianists - Matt McMahan, Bill Risby, Roger Dean and Peter Dasent explore the duo format
- Ben Hauptmann, Tim Clarkson and Aaron Flower premier new ensembles
- The Kinetic Jazz Orchestra will premier five new works and revisit some Gil Evans works.
- Urban Gypsies will join us to present a concert of passionate Latin gypsy jazz.
- Remco Keijzer returns to feature with Matt McMahan.
- Singers Tanya Sparke and Liz Geyer join Peter Dasent and Bill Risby respectively for an intimate journey through song.
- As a late night feature Kinetic Energy directors Graham Jones & Jepke Goudsmit will show a selection of archival video footage of their work.

We also have a conduction by Roger Dean performed by some of the leading young jazz artists in Sydney with film work by Saha Jones and have reserved some festival spots for the emerging young bands and players who have started to light up the Sydney Jazz scene.

As at all our January festivals, our pianists will enjoy the opportunity to explore the special range and scope of the Stuart piano through the kind sponsorship of Stuart & Sons and Albert Music.

The shows will take place in the Hall and the Church alternately, and will be recorded with some of the pieces being released later in the year on the 2013 Kinetic Jazz compilation CD.

CD's of participating artists will be available at the box office, including Kinetic Jazz CD 1 & 2.

The box office and café open 30min before the start of the first concert each day.
